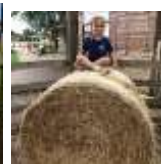

Reception-

In Reception this term, we are learning about Our Wonderful World. On Wednesday, we had a very exciting day, when we visited Odds Farm Park. The children were able to feed the pigs and goats. They listened carefully to a talk about the rabbits and then stroked them. We also went on a tractor ride and saw the Highland cows. They had just had babies and we saw one that was only three days old trying to stand up! We were very proud of how well the children managed the coach trip and a day out, away from school.

The Value of FSM and Pupil Premium

- Did you know?** For every child who is eligible and registered for Free School Meals, our school receives an extra **£1,515** in Pupil Premium funding. This money is vital for supporting your child's education.
- Did you know?** Pupil Premium is not just for meals. It's a key source of funding that schools use for things like academic support, school trips, and resources to help every child succeed.
- Did you know?** The funding from FSM applications helps to support additional staff, such as teaching assistants or specific interventions, to give children the extra help they need.
- Did you know?** Even though your child may benefit from Universal FSM, the school receives the extra £1,515 in Pupil Premium funding to support your child in our school.
