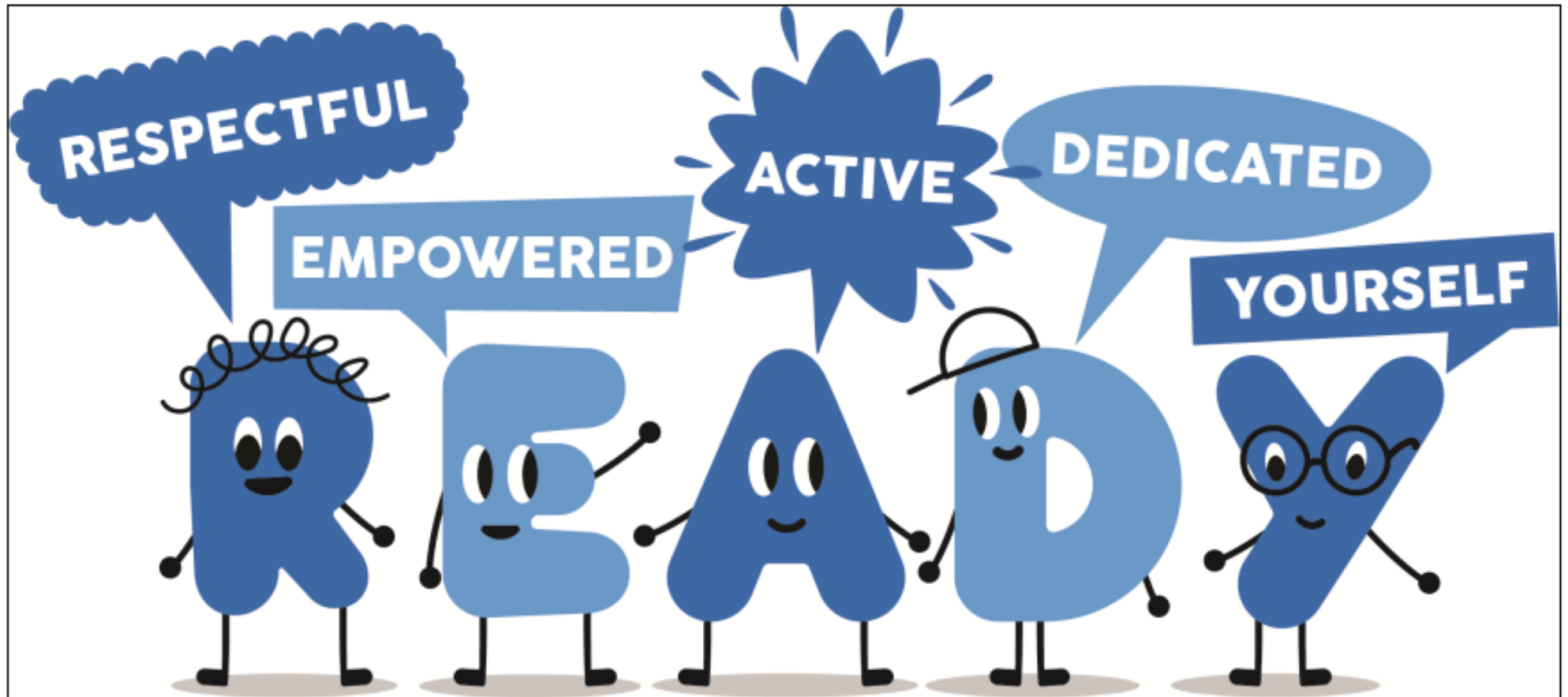
Mornings:

Daily routines and Timetable

- Each day we will have a soft start. The children begin with register and time to read their book and get themselves ready for the day.
- Phonics or Whole Class Reading
- Assembly – Key Stage/Class/Singing/Celebration
- Writing
- Maths
- History/Geography/Science/Art/PSHE
- PE – Every Wednesday and Thursday.



What to bring to school:

- Reading folder EVERY DAY.

RWI books are changed every Monday

AR books are changed after completing a quiz.

- Labelled water bottle:
 - **Must consist of water for the classroom.**
 - **Juice can be given for lunch time only.**
- Correct uniform and shoes – see Uniform Policy.
- All uniform/coats/winter clothing clearly labelled.
- *No large keyrings on bags or toys*



Reminder – Uniform

School uniform

- Grey school trousers / skirt/ shorts (any brand)
- White polo shirt (with or without logo) / shirt / blouse
- Royal blue and white summer dresses
- Royal blue sweatshirt / cardigan / jumper - with or without logo
- Grey / white socks or tights
- Black school shoes

PE uniform

- Royal blue t-shirt (with or without) logo
- Black tracksuit bottoms (plain)
- Black PE shorts (plain)
- Black hoody (with or without logo - no other logos, images or patterns permitted)
- Trainers or plimsolls

Other

- PE kits must be worn to school on PE day (except for Reception)
- Hair longer than shoulder length must be tied up at all times and accessories should be fitting with school uniform and functional. Large bows and other accessories are not permitted.
- Earrings must be small, plain studs. These must be removed for PE.

PE will be on Wednesday and Thursday. Children should come into school in their PE kit.



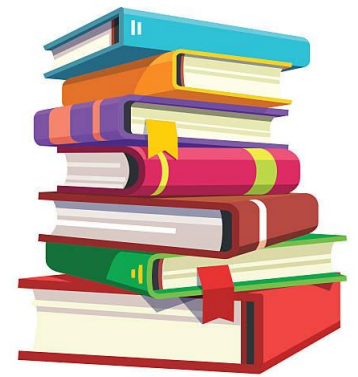
Lunch:

- Children will order their lunch during morning registration. Please spend some time each day talking with your child about what they will choose.
- Fruit is provided for break time. Your child does not need to bring their own snack.
- Healthy snacks can be provided in a named bag or pot.

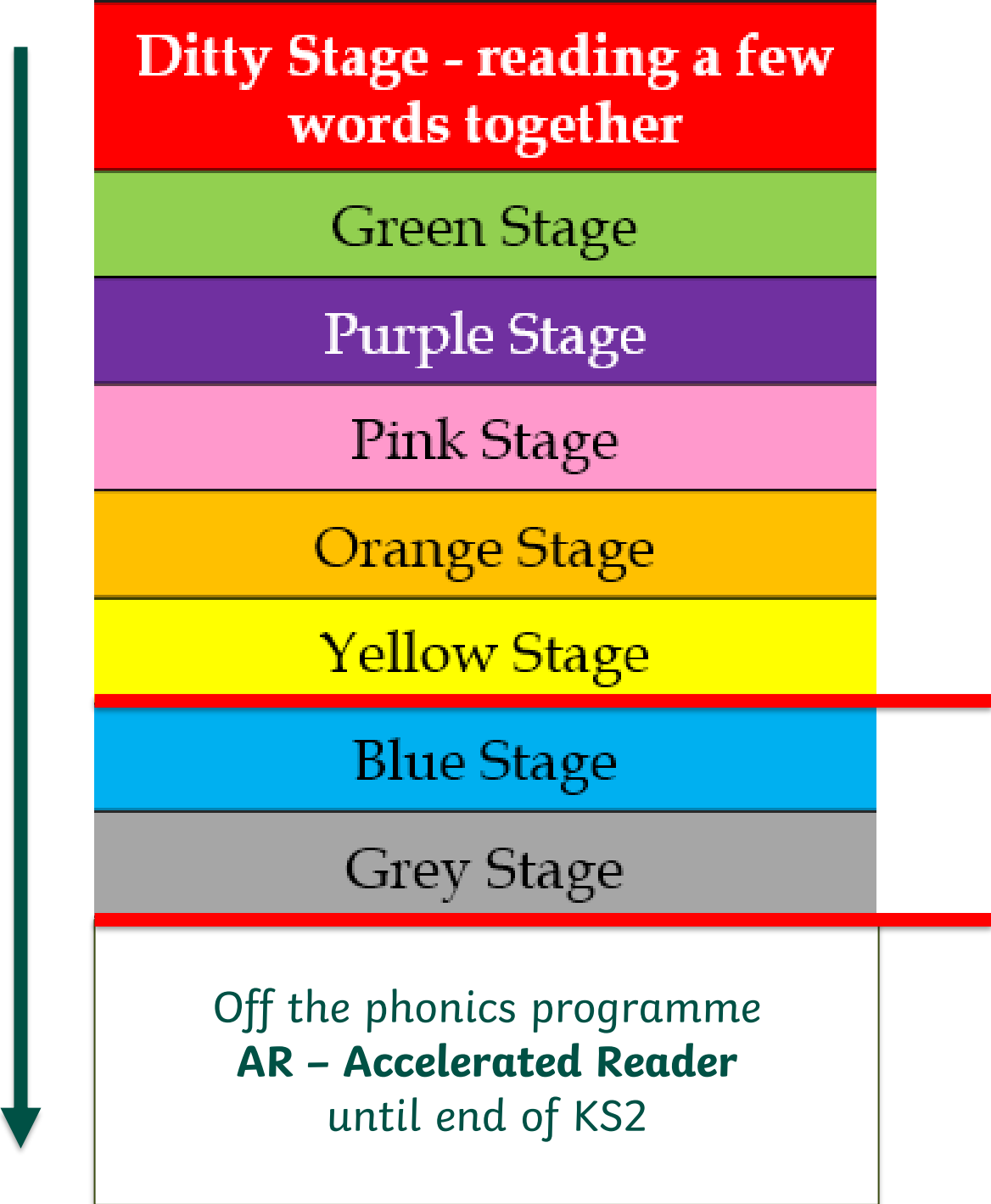


Reading:

- Children will bring home a RWI 'bookbag book' matched to their phonics groups with sounds familiar to them.
- In the front cover of each book, there is a parent guide to using it. To get the maximum benefit from these books we would encourage you to read each one **three times**.
- Reading more than once increases their confidence and fluency.
- At the end of each book, there are comprehension questions to talk about. Please continue to listen to your child read at home every day, even if it is only a couple of pages.
- Accelerated reader is the programme we use once phonics is completed.

until end of KS2

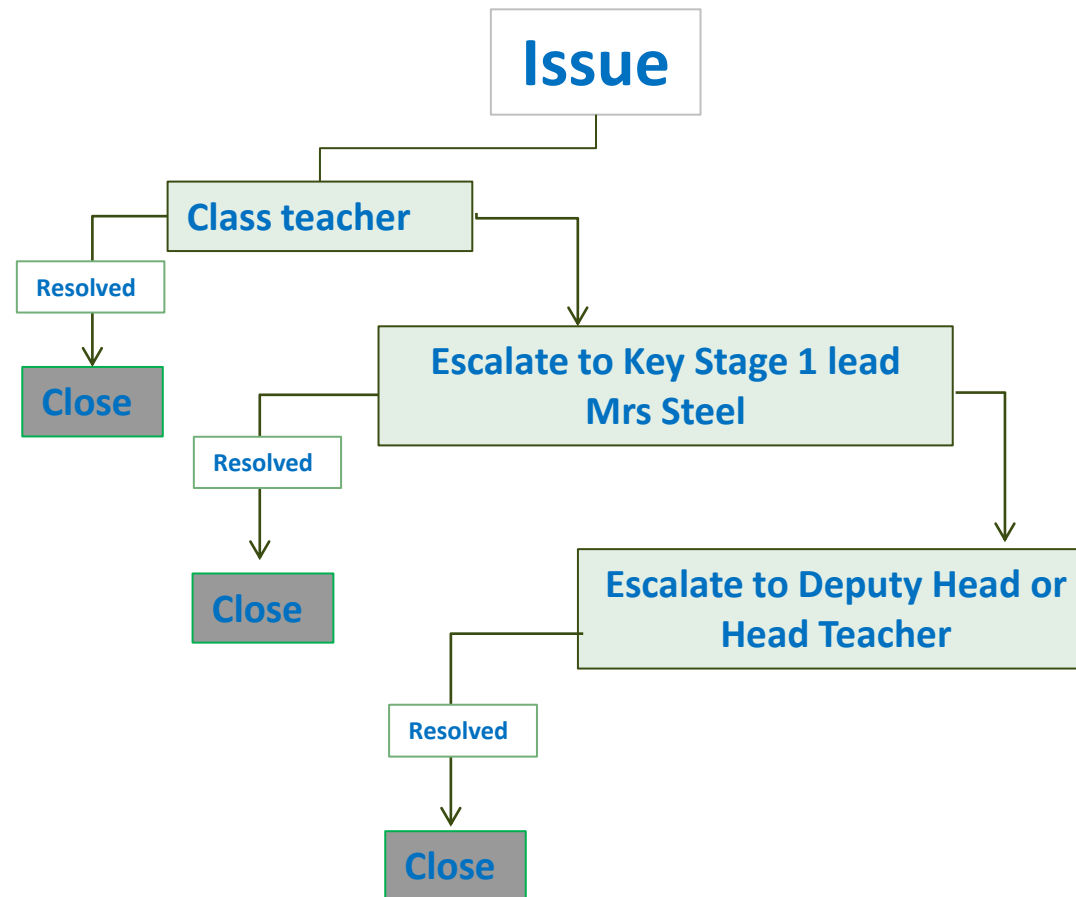
To achieve Blue book level, children have to read a passage at the appropriate level at 70+ words per minute.

Once children get to this level they will have an online quiz which will determine the correct level of reading book for their ability. Each book has a quiz that tests if they have read and understood the text.

Assessment:

- Children are assessed throughout the year.
- We use SATs and teacher judgement.
- Phonics assessments every half term.
- Big quizzes at the end of each topic, to show their learning.
- At the end of every writing unit there is a final piece of work.
- End of unit quizzes after each Maths unit.
