Breaktime snacks should **not** include crisps or chocolate.



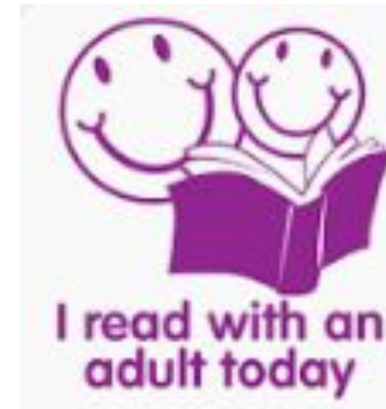

Home Learning:

Reading	Maths
Reading is the most important thing that you can do at home with your child to support their learning in school. Please find an opportunity every day for your child to read to you. Talk with them about the book and the characters in it, ask questions about what they think will happen next and talk about how the book makes them feel. Sign their reading record every time they read with you at home. Reading every day. Parents to initial and sign diary for at least 5 times a week (if child is reading books from level 5, they can sign their own reading record). This will be checked weekly. Record brought in everyday.	Support your child to chant the times tables, ask them quick recall questions, count in multiples of the number forwards and backwards. Times table rock stars

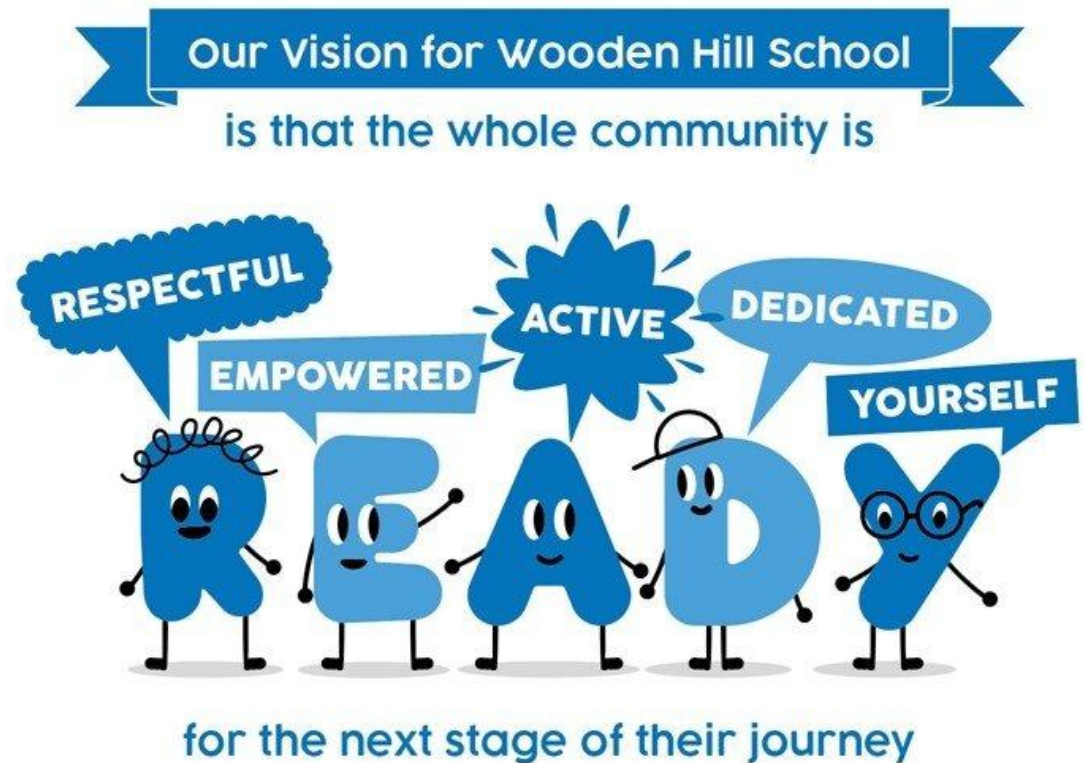

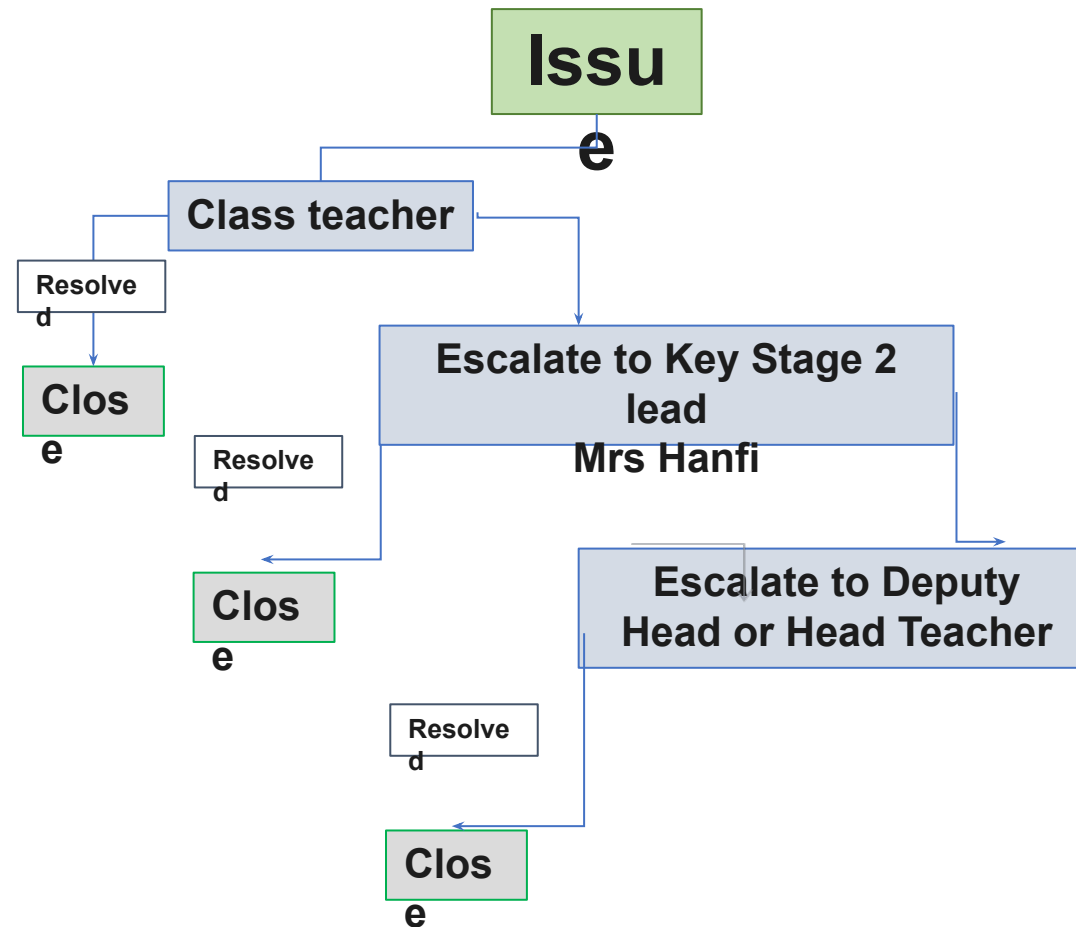
